## Dragon Storytime – SRP 2020 "Imagine Your Story"

Books: <u>How to catch a dragon</u> by Adam Wallace, <u>There's a dragon in your book</u> by Tom Fletcher, <u>Lovabye Dragon</u> by Barbara Joosse, and <u>How to dress a dragon</u> by Thelma Lynne Godin

Craft: Paper Roll Dragon from Deborah Chapman of onelittleproject.com

Supplies: Toilet paper roll, construction paper, scissors, glue, 2 large pom poms, 2 small pom poms, 2 wiggle eyes, and several strips of orange, red, and yellow streamers (the original craft calls for tissue paper).



1. Cut a construction paper square lengthwise to match the length of the roll and wide enough to wrap around the roll.

2. Glue the square to the roll.



3. Glue the wiggle eyes to the large pom poms.



4. Glue the large pom poms with the wiggle eyes to one end of the tube to make "eyes" and the small pom poms to the other end to make "nostrils".



5. Glue the streamers to the inside of the top of the tube on the end with the small pom poms.



6. Once dry, you can blow in the end with the large pom poms and make the streamers wave!
