



## Story Time Summer 2020 Week #1

(Nursery Rhymes) Toddler-School age

**Talk**: Welcome to our Imagine Your Story story time! Today we will read and sing nursery rhymes. Put on your thinking hat.......... What are some nursery rhymes you might know? (List answers on dry erase board to use for help recalling for songs)

Let's **shake your sillies out** (by Learning Station) before we read!

Read: Humpty Dumpty by Christopher Harbo

**Sing:** Teddy bear, teddy bear tune around. (Turn around)

Teddy bear, teddy bear touch the ground. (Touch the ground)

Teddy bear, teddy bear reach up high. (Arms up in the air)

Teddy bear, teddy bear tough the sky. (Point to the sky)

Teddy bear, teddy bear bend down low. (Reach down towards your toes)

Teddy bear, teddy bear touch your toes. (Touch your toes)

Teddy bear, teddy bear go upstairs. (March in place)

Teddy bear, teddy bear say your prayers.

Teddy bear, teddy bear turn out the light. (Pretend to switch off the light)

Teddy bear, teddy bear say good night. (Say good night)

Read: The Itsy Bitsy Spider by Iza Trapani

**Read:** Jack and Jill by Christopher Harbo

**Sing/ Movement:** Children share a few favorite nursery rhymes to sing.

Read: Little Bo Peep by Christopher Harbo

Read: Little Miss Muffet by Chirstopher Harb

**Talk**: Thank you for coming to story time, if you would like to join us with an activity to explore the nursery rhyme Jack be Nimble......... Build and a pretend candle stick with Legos and jump over it.
