Craft: Rapunzel's Castle

Supplies:

- -jumbo & mini craft sticks
- -glue
- -cardstock or construction paper
- -scissors
- -markers
- -small wiggle eyes
- -yellow yarn

Before your storytime:

- -Assemble the craft stick castle. Lay three jumbo craft sticks next to each other. Glue two mini craft sticks to the back of the jumbo craft sticks.
- -Using card stock cut out a triangle, door, and window for the castle, as well as a face for Rapunzel.

Directions for children:

- 1. First, gather your materials: craft stick tower, a triangle, door, window, and circle.
- 2. Next, begin gluing the triangle to the top of the craft sticks and door to the bottom.
- 3. Then, use markers and wiggle eyes to give Rapunzel a face.
- 4. Next, take three pieces of yellow yarn to give Rapunzel her long, long, long hair.
- 5. Finally, glue Rapunzel's head unto the window then glue the window to the triangle part of the tower.
