..... wear your suit (ziiiiiip) ... wear your gloves (clap, clap) wear your helmet (pat, pat) Then we blast off!

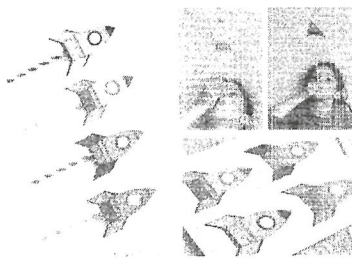
Read: Pete the Cat Out of This World by James Dean

Read: There was a Bold Lady by Charise Mericle Harper

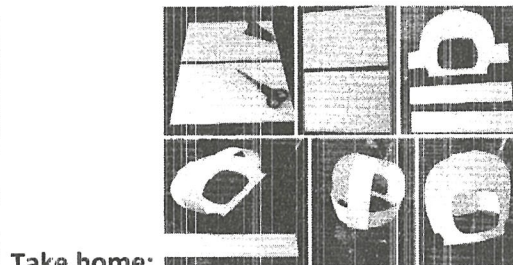
Sing/ Movement: Twinkle Twinkle Little Star (Teach to children the song in sign language)
